Scenario	Considerations / response
<p>Scenario 1:</p> <p>A parent writes to school council because he believes that the menu offered by the canteen is unsuitable. He has attached a petition that contains 50 supporting signatures in support of this.</p>	
<p>Scenario 2:</p> <p>A teacher has been appointed to a position for one year at the school. The position is to be advertised and the teacher is keen to retain the position. The teacher has garnered a group of supporters among the parents, including one on school council who has promised to raise the issue at the next Council.</p>	
<p>Scenario 3:</p> <p>You were elected to council as a parent member. You are also a member of the school's Parents Club. School council has proposed changes to the Volunteers policy, changes that are concerning the Parents Club. The group has asked you to vote against the recommendations when they are put up at the council meeting. How would you respond?</p>
